CLIENTS HELPED THROUGH UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Each year, hundreds of residents in Oakland and Livingston Counties are assisted with heating emergencies by accessing OLHSA's Emergency Utility Assistance Program, which is funded by Walk for Warmth and other assistance programs. OLHSA hopes to help even more families in 2017 stay safe and comfortable in their homes.

In 2016 The Emergency Utility Assistance Program helped:

In Oakland County:

- 520 families
- 1,362 individuals
- Percentage of single parent families: 44%
- Percentage of families 100% of poverty and below: 65%
- Percentage of those helped who are children: 44%
- Percentage of those who are helped are elderly: 9%
- Percentage of those who are helped who are disabled: 16%

In Livingston County:

- 240 families
- 648 individuals
- Percentage of single parent families: 31%
- Percentage of families 100% of poverty and below: 58%
- Percentage of those helped who are children: 41%
- Percentage of those who are helped are elderly: 8%
- Percentage of those who are helped who are disabled: 24%
