Minor Home Repairs: replace/repair pipes, faucets, and toilets; repair tables, floorboards, railings, and drawers; re-hanging doors; replace fuses, bulbs, plugs, frayed cords, and batteries in smoke detectors; replace bathroom fans.

Home Safety Devices: install tub grab bars and stair/hall grab bars; deliver shower chairs, transfer benches, hand-held showerhead, smoke alarm, Co detector, raised toilet seats, tub mats, and bedside commode; other home safety devices available.
